### Programme budget implications of draft resolution [A/79/L.21](#)

#### Report of the Fifth Committee

*Rapporteur: Mr. Elaye-Djibril Yacin Abdillahi (Djibouti)*

1. At its 20th and resumed 22nd meetings, on 16 and 24 December 2024, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement submitted by the Secretary-General on the programme budget implications of draft resolution [A/79/L.21 \(A/C.5/79/26\)](#) and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions ([A/79/7/Add.33](#)). The statements and comments made in the course of the Fifth Committee's consideration of this question are reflected in the relevant summary records.<sup>1</sup>

2. At its resumed 22nd meeting, on 24 December, the Committee had before it a draft decision ([A/C.5/79/L.22](#), sect. L), submitted by the Chair of the Committee on the basis of informal consultations coordinated by the representative of Guinea. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft decision [A/C.5/79/L.22](#) without a vote (see para. 3).

### **Decision of the Fifth Committee**

3. The Fifth Committee, having considered the statement of programme budget implications submitted by the Secretary-General<sup>1</sup> and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>2</sup> decides to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution [A/79/L.21](#), additional resource requirements amounting to 581,500 United States dollars would be required for 2025, comprising 73,500 dollars under section 2, General Assembly and Economic and Social Council affairs and conference management, and 508,000 dollars under section 10, Least developed countries, landlocked developing countries and small island developing States, of the proposed programme budget for 2025, representing a charge against the contingency fund, together with an amount of 39,300 dollars under section 36, Staff assessment, to be offset by an equivalent amount under income section 1, Income from staff assessment.
