APPROVAL OF A SUPPLEMENTARY AGREEMENT WITH THE UNIVERSAL POSTAL UNION CONCERNING THE USE OF THE UNITED NATIONS LAISSEZ-PASSER

Report of the Sixth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. E. FERRER VILEYRA (Argentina)

1. In implementation of resolution 136 (VI) adopted by the Economic and Social Council on 25 February 1948, the Secretary-General concluded with the Universal Postal Union an agreement, supplementary to the agreement linking this specialized agency with the United Nations, to extend to officials of that agency the benefit of the provisions of article VII of the Convention on Privileges and Immunities of the United Nations.
2. The Secretary-General reported on this matter (A/944) to the General Assembly, to which the supplementary agreement in question was submitted for approval.
3. On 22 September 1949, the General Assembly decided to refer this question for study to the Sixth Committee, which examined it at its 164th meeting held on 15 October 1949. At that meeting, the Committee adopted, by 41 votes to none, with no abstentions, a draft resolution submitted by the representative of France approving the supplementary agreement in question.
4. The Sixth Committee accordingly submits the following draft resolution to the General Assembly for approval.

APPROVAL OF A SUPPLEMENTARY AGREEMENT WITH THE UNIVERSAL POSTAL UNION CONCERNING THE USE OF THE UNITED NATIONS LAISSEZ-PASSER

The General Assembly

Approves the supplementary agreement between the United Nations and the Universal Postal Union signed on 13 and 27 July 1949 concerning the use of the United Nations laissez-passer.
