> FROHIBITION OF THE ATOMIC WEAPON AND REDUCTION BY ONE-THIRD OF THE ARMAMENTS AND ARMED FORCES OF THE PERMANENT MEMBERS OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL: RESOLUTION OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Note by the Secretary-General*

1. The Secretary-General has the honour to draw the attention of the Nembers of the General Assembly to the following resolution adopted by the Security Council at its 452nd meeting held on 18 October 1949:

"The Security Council,

"<u>Having received</u> and examined the proposals contained in the working document on the implementation of General Assembly resolution 192 (III) of 19 November 1948, adopted by the Commission for Conventional Armaments at its 19th meeting held on 1 August 1949,

<u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General to transmit these proposals and the records of the discussions on this question in the Security Council and the Commission for Conventional Armaments to the General Assembly".

2. In accordance with the instructions given in the above resolution, the Secretary-General transmits to Members of the General Assembly the proposals submitted by the Commission for Conventional Armaments on the implementation of General Assembly resolution 192 (III)**, the verbatim records of the 407th, 408th, 450th, 451st and 452nd meetings of the Security Council***, and the records of the discussion of this question in the Commission for Conventional Armaments****.
