APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF SUBSIDIARY BODIES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

> ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY QUESTIONS

Note by the Secretary-General

1. At its eighth session, the General Assembly, by resolution 762(VIII), appointed Mr. G.R. Kamat (India) to be a member of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions for a three-year term, commencing on 1 January 1954.

2. In a letter dated 3 October 1955, addressed to the Secretary-General, Mr. G.R. Kamat has submitted his resignation from the membership of the Committee, effective 31 December 1955.

3. Thus in addition to the three vacancies in the membership of the Committee to which it will be necessary for the General Assembly to appoint members for a three-year term to commence on 1 January 1956 (A/2925), there now exists a further vacancy for the unexpired term of office of Mr. Kamat, that is 1 January 1956 to 31 December 1956, to which it will also be necessary for the General Assembly to appoint a member.
