## Resolution 2778 (2025)

**Adopted by the Security Council at its 9909th meeting, on  
30 April 2025**

*The Security Council,*

*Recalling* its previous resolutions, statements of its President, and press statements concerning the situation in South Sudan,

*Determining* that the situation in South Sudan continues to constitute a threat to international peace and security in the region,

*Acting* under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations,

1. *Decides* to extend the mandate of the United Nations Mission in the Republic of South Sudan (UNMISS), as set out in resolution [2729 \(2024\)](#), until 9 May 2025, and authorizes UNMISS to use all necessary means to carry out its tasks;
  2. *Decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
