Letter dated 8 February 1983 from Mr. Nail Atalay
to the Secretary-General

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to refer to the letter of the representative of the Greek Cypriot administration which was circulated as a document of the General Assembly and of the Security Council (A/37/777-S/15528), complaining about the violation of the territorial waters of the Greek Cypriot administration.

The allegation of Mr. Moushoutas concerning the violation of the territorial waters of south Cyprus on 3 December 1982 deserves no reply, since the area in question is under the full control and sovereignty of the Turkish Federated State of Kibris.

Furthermore, I would like to reaffirm again that unilateral actions pursued by the Greek Cypriot administration, including changing its territorial waters from 3-mile to 12-mile in 1964, without the participation of the Turkish Cypriot side are devoid of any legality and consequently not binding on the Turkish Cypriot community, the co-founder partner of the Republic since 1960.

I should be grateful if this letter were circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda item 37, and of the Security Council.
