Australia: draft decision

The Preparatory Committee decides to request the Secretary-General to submit to the Economic and Social Council at the resumed part of its Second Regular Session, 1978, a detailed programme of information activities for the Conference. The programme should be accompanied by cost estimates in order that it may be considered by the Council, together with the other proposals contained in the report of the Preparatory Committee on the work done at its first session (A/CONF.) so that they may be presented together to the General Assembly at its thirty-third session.

The programme, which should draw on the suggestions contained in document A/CONF.94/PC/L.3 and submitted in debate during the first session of the Preparatory Committee, should contain proposals for the widest possible publicity, emphasizing the purposes and objectives of the Conference and its meaning for the women of all countries. This process of gradual education should commence at the earliest possible date and must be aimed at all media and information outlets.
