## 2025 年 6 月 30 日塞浦路斯常驻联合国代表给秘书长的信

奉我国政府指示，谨随函转递 12 份单独附件，其中记录了 2024 年 7 月至 12 月期间土耳其空军和海军侵犯塞浦路斯领空、违反塞浦路斯飞行情报区国际空中交通管制条例、侵犯塞浦路斯领水以及非法使用塞浦路斯境内非开放港口和机场的行为。

在上述期间，共观察到 989 起空中和 45 起海上违反事件。应当指出，在 989 起空中违反事件中，有 264 起涉及使用土耳其军用无人机。此外，土耳其还侵犯塞浦路斯共和国领空进行军事演习，并非法发布了 5 份飞行员通知和 12 份航行通告。

这些行动侵犯了塞浦路斯的主权、独立和领土完整，因此违反了《联合国宪章》。这些行动还破坏了区域稳定、和平以及在安全理事会决议框架内公正持久解决塞浦路斯问题的前景。

对岛上军事现状的不断破坏，几乎每天向缓冲区推进，以及在已经高度军事化的被占地区不断升级军事基础设施，只是土耳其在塞浦路斯持续侵略行为的一小部分。土耳其占领军多次实施军事侵犯并向前推进，目的是在当地制造新的既成事实，同时严重影响平民的安全感。这种行动暴露了安卡拉永久占领的意图，不仅对塞浦路斯的安全、主权和领土完整，而且对我们本已动荡地区的安全和稳定构成严重威胁。

土耳其继续违反《联合国宪章》的行为表明它公然蔑视国际法。这在瓦沙尤其明显，虽然安全理事会明确呼吁(见 [S/PRST/2021/13](#))土耳其方面停止并扭转破坏现状的行为，但非法改变围封区的行为却是有增无减，并且完全无视安



全理事会第 550 (1984)号决议，其中安理会呼吁将瓦罗沙归还其合法居民，并将该地区移交给联合国管理。

对塞浦路斯的持续非法占领及其给我们的岛屿和人民造成的悲惨后果，是今天我们必须克服的不可接受和不可持续的现状的关键所在。相反，作为入侵者和占领方，土耳其正在加紧在岛上推行“两国方案”。土耳其对安全理事会决议采取“为我所用”的做法，在决议不符合其言论时选择将其称为过时决议，并呼吁国际社会“面对实地的现实”，试图说服国际社会相信其侵略的结果具有有效的法律效力。

在当前全球地缘政治背景下，联合国必须表明，在适用《宪章》方面没有双重标准。必须捍卫受到攻击的国家的主权和领土完整，无论攻击来自何方，也无论攻击过去了多长时间。就塞浦路斯而言，问题仍然是军事入侵和持续非法占领，是不断侵犯人权和违反国际合法性，违反《宪章》和安全理事会决议已令人不安地成为常态。对《宪章》的选择性遵守可能破坏我们集体和平与安全所依赖的框架。《宪章》的原则对所有会员国都具有约束力——如果允许一国例外，整个体系的合法性将受到质疑。正因为如此，安全理事会必须支持其通过的决议，并确保决议具有意义；否则，国际体系的信誉和联合国力求保护的基于规则的国际秩序将受到严重损害。

我们目前正处于一个敏感时期，正在进行外交接触，以期为恢复正式谈判创造条件。玛丽亚·安赫拉·奥尔古因·奎利亚尔再次被任命为你的个人特使，为实现这一目标注入了新的动力，包括在你的指导下推动执行双方领导人商定的建立信任措施。不幸的是，这一努力继续受到破坏，土耳其方面坚持的立场完全脱离了联合国关于解决塞浦路斯问题的既定范围。与此同时，这种不可接受的立场日益体现于塞浦路斯当地的挑衅行动以及加紧促使分离主义实体国际地位升级的行动之中。为一秉诚意地恢复谈判，土耳其必须尊重塞浦路斯的主权和领土完整，不再采取任何非法行动。

尽管土耳其及其附庸地方行政当局给我们设置障碍，但是塞浦路斯共和国仍坚定致力于根据联合国认可的基础，即按照安全理事会决议的规定，建立政治平等的两区两族联邦，和平解决塞浦路斯问题。这一商定框架是解决塞浦路斯问题唯一可行的路径，在这方面，塞浦路斯共和国政府将尽一切努力与你和你的个人特使合作，为恢复正式谈判创造条件，以期实现塞浦路斯及其人民的重新统一。

请将本信及其附件作为大会议程项目 40 的文件和安全理事会文件分发给荷。
