

Comprehensive study on the implementation of the Durban Declaration and Programme of Action

Note by the Secretariat

- 1. The Human Rights Council, in paragraph 23 of its resolution 51/32, entitled "From rhetoric to reality: a global call for concrete action against racism, racial discrimination, xenophobia and related intolerance", adopted on 7 October 2022, requested the Group of Independent Eminent Experts on the Implementation of the Durban Declaration and Programme of Action to prepare a comprehensive study on the implementation of the Durban Declaration and Programme of Action, with a focus on areas presenting particular challenges, and to present it to the Council at its sixtieth session and to the General Assembly at its eightieth session.
- 2. Pursuant to that request, the study was submitted to the Human Rights Council in document A/HRC/60/74. The Secretariat therefore has the honour to refer the General Assembly to that document.
