Page 2 - (Right hand column) Article 1 (a) line before last:

Replace the words "duly licensed" by the words "legally operated" so that the sentence will read as follows:

"(a) Each Contracting State shall secure to its own nationals and to such of the nationals of every other Contracting State as are lawfully within its territory freedom to receive and impart without governmental interference information and opinions regardless of frontiers, orally, in writing or in print, in the form of art, or by legally operated visual or auditory devices."^{1/}
