Yemen Arab Republic: draft resolution

The General Assembly,

Having considered the report of the Secretary-General "Respect for privileges and immunities of officials of the United Nations and the specialized agencies and related organizations" (A/C.5/37/34),

<u>Drawing attention</u> to the unprecedented character of the mass arrest by the Israeli authorities in the territory of Lebanon of great number of the UNRWA officials, and as mentioned in paragraph 6 of the Secretary-General's report "Respect for privileges and immunities of officials of the United Nations and the specialized agencies and related organizations" (A/C.5/37/34),

- 1. Calls upon the Secretary-General to take measures without delay to establish the whereabouts, to find out the charges made and to arrange a meeting with the UNRWA officials incarcerated by the Israeli authorities in Lebanon, in order to obtain their earliest release;
- 2. Requests the Secretary-General to promptly inform Member States about measures taken under paragraph 1 above and about their results.
