### Scale of assessments for the apportionment of the expenses of the United Nations

#### Report of the Fifth Committee

#### I. Introduction

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 12 September 2025, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its eightieth session the item entitled “Scale of assessments for the apportionment of the expenses of the United Nations” and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.

2. The Fifth Committee considered the item at its 1st and 2nd meetings, on 6 and 7 October 2025. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee’s consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records.<sup>1</sup>

#### II. Consideration of draft resolution [A/C.5/80/L.2](#)

4. At its 2nd meeting, on 7 October, the Committee had before it a draft resolution entitled “Scale of assessments for the apportionment of the expenses of the United Nations: requests under Article 19 of the Charter” ([A/C.5/80/L.2](#)), submitted by the Chair of the Committee on the basis of informal consultations coordinated by the representative of Guinea.

5. Also at the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft resolution [A/C.5/80/L.2](#) without a vote (see para. 6).

### III. Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

6. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

#### **Scale of assessments for the apportionment of the expenses of the United Nations: requests under Article 19 of the Charter**

*The General Assembly,*

*Having considered* chapter V of the report of the Committee on Contributions on its eighty-fifth session,<sup>1</sup>

*Reaffirming* the obligation of Member States under Article 17 of the Charter of the United Nations to bear the expenses of the Organization as apportioned by the General Assembly,

1. *Reaffirms* its role in accordance with the provisions of Article 19 of the Charter of the United Nations and the advisory role of the Committee on Contributions in accordance with rule 160 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly;

2. *Also reaffirms* its resolution [54/237](#) C of 23 December 1999;

3. *Requests* the Secretary-General to continue to bring to the attention of Member States the deadline specified in resolution [54/237](#) C, including through an early announcement in the *Journal of the United Nations* and through direct communication;

4. *Urges* all Member States requesting exemption under Article 19 of the Charter to submit as much information as possible in support of their requests and to consider submitting such information in advance of the deadline specified in resolution [54/237](#) C so as to enable the collation of any additional detailed information that may be necessary;

5. *Agrees* that the failure of Bolivia (Plurinational State of) and Sao Tome and Principe to pay the full minimum amount necessary to avoid the application of Article 19 of the Charter was due to conditions beyond their control;

6. *Decides* that Bolivia (Plurinational State of) and Sao Tome and Principe shall be permitted to vote in the General Assembly until the end of its eightieth session.
