## The General Assembly

- 1. Takes note of the report of the Joint Inspection Unit (A/37/358 and Corr.l and 2 and the comments thereon of the Secretary-General (A/37/358/Add.l) as well as the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/37/684);
- 2. Requests the Secretary-General to include in his future reports on experts and consultants detailed information on the employment of former staff members, including the date of separation from the Organization, the period of post-separation employment and how much was paid to the former staff member;
- 3. Decides that, as an interim measure, no former staff member who is in receipt of a pension benefit from the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund shall receive from United Nations funds, regular budget or extrabudgetary, for work performed by him under contract or a special service agreement, emoluments in a total amount exceeding \$12,000 in any one calendar year.
- 4. Decides further to review the situation at its thirty-ninth session in the light of the additional information to be provided by the Secretary-General in response to the request addressed to him in paragraph 1 of this decision.
