Committee on Relations with the Host Country

Letter dated 27 October 2025 from the Permanent Representative of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee on Relations with the Host Country

I have the honour to address you, in your capacity as Chair of the Committee on Relations with the Host Country, and would like to refer to my previous communications, inter alia, the letters dated 1, 3 and 10 October 2025, respectively, as well as the statements delivered by my delegation in the meetings of the Committee on Relations with the Host Country, including the meetings held on 12 September and 24 October 2025 concerning the imposition by the United States of further impediments against Iranian representatives.

In this connection, I would like to express my gravest concerns as to the persistent and recurrent violations of international obligations by the United States, the host country, in particular, its recent unlawful measures against Iranian representatives, which obstruct and undermine the independent exercise and efficient performance of their functions, including but not limited to:

1. Significantly late issuance of visas, including to the Iranian President and Foreign Minister for the high-level week of the eightieth session of the General Assembly;
2. Non-issuance of visas to Iranian representatives, including those intending to participate in the committees of the General Assembly and International Law Week;
3. Non-issuance of visas to nearly half of the Iranian delegation for the high-level week of the eightieth session of the General Assembly;
4. Restrictions on the freedom of movement of representatives, including a perimeter with a radius of less than half a mile imposed on the Iranian high-level delegation during the high-level week of the eightieth session of the General Assembly;
5. Conducting a disrespectful secondary screening procedure against an Iranian representative at John F. Kennedy International Airport, New York;
6. Impeding and obstructing the participation of Iranian representatives in several high-level multilateral meetings during the high-level week of the eightieth session of the General Assembly;
7. Interfering with the inviolability of Iranian representatives, including by intrusive measures.

In light of the foregoing, recalling resolution [2819 \(XXVI\)](#), entitled “Security of missions accredited to the United Nations and safety of their personnel and



establishment of the Committee on Relations with the Host Country” and the decision of the Committee endorsed by the General Assembly (see [A/50/26](#)), I would like to hereby request the convening of an emergency meeting of said Committee on an urgent basis and at the soonest to address the violations of the United States and safeguard the rights and prerogatives of the Islamic Republic of Iran as a State Member of the United Nations.

It would be appreciated if the esteemed Chair of the Committee could kindly transmit the present letter to the Secretary-General and have it circulated among the States members of the Committee on Relations with the Host Country as a document of the Committee. I would like to request that the Chair also invite the United Nations Legal Counsel to participate in the above-mentioned emergency meeting.
