## Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 71st meeting, on 15 December 1982, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/37/96) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution I recommended by the Second Committee in paragraph 16 of its report (A/37/680/Add.1). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/37/SR.71).

## DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution I recommended by the Second Committee in paragraph 16 of its report (A/37/680/Add.1), no additional appropriation would be required under the programme budget for the biennium 1982-1983. Conference-servicing requirements would arise in 1984 which are estimated, on a full-cost basis and at 1983 rates, at \$547,300. The actual appropriations that might be required in that respect would be considered in the context of the proposed programme budget for 1984-1985.
