Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 71st meeting, on 15 December 1982, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/37/96) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution I recommended by the Second Committee in paragraph 16 of its report (A/37/680/Add.1). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/37/SR.71).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution I recommended by the Second Committee in paragraph 16 of its report (A/37/680/Add.1), no additional appropriation would be required under the programme budget for the biennium 1982-1983. Conference-servicing requirements would arise in 1984 which are estimated, on a full-cost basis and at 1983 rates, at \$547,300. The actual appropriations that might be required in that respect would be considered in the context of the proposed programme budget for 1984-1985.
