- 1. At its 61st meeting, on 9 December 1982, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statements by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/37/71 and A/C.5/37/72) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolutions II and III recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 79 of its report (A/37/745). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/37/SR.61).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolutions II and III recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 79 of its report (A/37/745), conference-servicing costs would arise, which are estimated, on a full-cost basis at \$159,700 and \$516,400 respectively. The actual additional appropriations that might be required in this respect would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of total conference-servicing requirements to be submitted to the General Assembly at a later stage during the current session.
