The successor programming arrangements

Earmarkings for the target for resource assignment from the core for 2001-2003

I. Purpose

1. Pursuant to the request of the Executive Board in paragraph 12 of its decision 99/2, the preliminary target for resource assignment from the core (TRAC) figures under line 1.1.1 for individual recipient countries were provided at the second regular session 1999 (see document DP/1999/27).
2. In the present document, the Administrator provides the revised and final TRAC earmarkings for 2001-2003.

II. TRAC earmarkings for 2001-2003

3. UNDP will consider revisions to the base year (1997) gross national product (GNP) per capita for resource distribution purposes within one year after the calculations of the preliminary TRAC earmarkings.¹ Thereafter, a revision will be considered only if (a) there is a variance of at least 10 per cent from the figure originally used, or (b) the revised GNP per capita falls below one of the thresholds used in the calculations or used to establish government local

office cost (GLOC) obligations. No downward adjustments of preliminary figures are made where there are increases in the GNP per capita.

4. Since the adoption of Executive Board decision 99/2 and the subsequent calculation of preliminary TRAC earmarkings, the 1997 GNP per capita estimates for 45 countries have been revised downward. This has resulted in higher TRAC earmarkings for 20 countries. The preliminary TRACs for the remaining 25 countries were determined by the floor principle and the calculations using the revised lower GNP per capita does not result in earmarkings above the earlier established floor amounts.

Earmarking for East Timor

5. In its decision 2000/2, the Executive Board approved the allocation of \$5 million to East Timor for the period 1999-2000. As reliable GNP per capita data is not available for East Timor, this figure represents in essence an agreement on the minimum critical mass of TRAC resources required for an initial two-year period. (The only estimate available is a 1996 figure of \$431 gross domestic product (GDP) per capita cited in the East Timor Joint Assessment Mission Report.)

6. Given annual total resources of \$750 million, the figure of \$5 million would correspond with a TRAC earmarking for the period 1999-2000 calculated on the

basis of a 1994 GNP per capita of around \$290, taking into consideration the independence bonus.

7. Hence, in view of the lack of reliable GNP per capita data, the figure of \$290 has been used for calculating a TRAC earmarking for 2001-2003. This results in a preliminary earmarking from TRAC line 1.1.1 of \$4,911,000 for the three-year period. This figure will be reviewed once a more reliable 1997 GNP per capita becomes available.

Unallocated reserve

8. In accordance with its decision 99/2, the Executive Board established an unallocated reserve of \$30 million to finance, *inter alia*, \$3,330,000 of TRAC requirements related to net contributor countries (NCCs) and any upward revisions that arise from changes to 1997 data reported during 1999.

The total increase in TRAC resources from line 1.1.1 and 1.1.2 resulting from changes in data and the establishment of an earmarking for East Timor amounts to \$28,749,000 for the three-year period. The TRAC earmarkings for NCCs has decreased from \$3,330,000 to \$2,330,000 as Chile's GNP per capita has fallen below the NCC threshold of \$4,700. Consequently, with only \$30 million in the reserve, the total amount of \$31,075,000 in additional TRAC earmarkings and earlier established allocations related to NCCs cannot be fully funded. However, the unfunded amount of \$1,075,000 should be considered in the light of the dynamic resource planning process of UNDP and can be accommodated in the context of future assignments from line 1.1.2 and/or further adjustments in TRAC earmarkings based on available resources.

Effects on the overall distribution of earmarkings

10. Table 1 below provides a summary of the final earmarkings for total TRAC resources under lines 1.1.1 and 1.1.2 for the period 2001-2003, broken down by category of country and by region. Table 2 provides the final earmarkings under line 1.1.1 for individual recipient countries, grouped by region. The calculations are based on latest available 1997 World Bank data on GNP per capita. Those countries where changes have occurred are shown with an asterisk.

11. In its decision 99/2, the Executive Board also decided that NCCs are to be treated as a separate group of programme countries outside the TRAC distribution

model. The respective TRAC-1 earmarkings for the grace period were to be calculated at 60 per cent of their previous TRAC and to be financed from the unallocated reserve. (See document DP/1999/27 for details on the new arrangement.) Table 3 below shows the complete list of NCCs as of 2001, based on revised 1997 GNP per capita data and the current threshold of \$4,700. As of 2001 there are three new NCCs.

12. It may be recalled that an important element of the successor programming arrangements was the attainment of the target of \$1.1 billion annually for total resources for 2001-2003. The TRAC figures shown in the tables below have been calculated using this financial framework.

13. It should be noted, however, as explained in document DP/1999/27, that the Administrator is authorized to adjust programming levels on a proportionate basis in line with estimates of resource availability for the period vis-à-vis the planning target (in accordance with paragraph 25 of decision 95/23). Thus, in releasing resources for programming, the annualized TRAC earmarkings shown in tables 2 and 3, as well as the earmarkings for all other programme lines of the financial framework, will be adjusted on an across-the-board basis, in keeping with the latest estimates of voluntary contributions taking into account the provisions of the biennial budget approved by the Executive Board.

III. Executive Board action

14. The Executive Board may wish to take note of the final TRAC earmarkings under line 1.1.1 as shown in tables 1, 2 and 3 of the present document.
