

The following intergovernmental organizations were represented: Asian-African Legal Consultative Committee, Commonwealth of Independent States, Council of Europe, European Community, International Organization of la Francophonie, Organization of African Unity, Organization of the Islamic Conference and Organization of American States.
- 8. The International Committee of the Red Cross and the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies, entities invited to participate in the sessions and work of the General Assembly, were also represented by observers.
- 9. In accordance with decision 7 of the Preparatory Committee, adopted at its organizational session in May 1998, a number of non-governmental organizations also attended the session.
