Note verbale dated 18 April 2000 from the Permanent Mission of Luxembourg to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999) concerning Afghanistan and, with reference to his note verbale dated 19 January 2000, has the honour to inform the Committee of the following.

On 15 November 1999, the Council of the European Union adopted a common position with regard to the restrictive measures imposed against the Taliban, as set forth in Security Council resolution 1267 (1999). The application of this common position necessitated the adoption of a Council regulation concerning the prohibition of flights and the freezing of funds and other financial resources imposed against the Taliban of Afghanistan. The Council regulation took effect on 17 February 2000, and it is mandatory in all its elements and is directly applicable to the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg.
