**Letter dated 12 May 2000 from the Chargé d'affaires a.i. of
the Permanent Mission of Yugoslavia to the United Nations
addressed to the President of the Security Council**

I have been instructed by my Government to lodge a strong protest at the violation of the air space of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia by SFOR on 27 April 2000. On that day between 9.30 and 10 p.m. the State border authorities of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia at the border post of Mali Zvornik, the border unit of Loznica, noticed an SFOR helicopter which violated the air space of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia on a number of occasions at the region of Mali Zvornik 700 metres deep in the territory of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia.

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
