^a This table shows the amounts of the estimated expenditure actually approved under regular budgets plus any approved supplementary estimates, net of staff assessment. No adjustments have been made in the figures. Where the estimates approved make provision for an amount for an undistributed reserve, it is excluded from the figures, so that the comparisons relate to effective working budgets. Estimated expenditure for the support of extrabudgetary activities is included where and to the extent that it is integrated into the regular budget. Estimated budgetary reimbursements to accounts drawn upon to finance expenditure under the budget or supplementary authorizations are reported in the period of reimbursement. Figures for biennial budgets are divided into two equal annual amounts; supplementary estimates are reported according to the years to which they relate. Where budgets are denominated in a currency other than the United States dollar, the amounts reported are translated into the dollar at the United Nations operational rate of exchange at the end of each year, except for the 1998 and 1999 figures, which have been translated at the December 1997 rate. Rates used are as follows: (a) Swiss francs to the dollar (UPU, ITU, WMO, WIPO): 1990 - 1.27; 1991 - 1.43; 1992 - 1.44; 1993 - 1.49; 1994 - 1.32; 1995 - 1.16; 1996 - 1.29; 1997-1999 - 1.42; (b) dollars to pounds sterling (IMO, from 1990): 1990 - 1.97; 1991 - 1.77; 1992 - 1.51; 1993 - 1.49; 1994 - 1.56; 1995 - 1.54; 1996 - 1.68; 1997 - 1.67; and 1998-1999 - 1.61.
