**Kenya, Uganda and United Republic of Tanzania: draft resolution**

**Pattern of conferences**

*The General Assembly,*

*Recalling* its resolution 54/248 of 23 December 1999, in particular section B, paragraph 23,

*Having considered* the letter dated 8 May 2000 from the Chairman of the Committee on Conferences to the Chairman of the Fifth Committee,<sup>1</sup>

1. *Decides* to authorize the Committee on Conferences to hold its 2000 substantive session at the United Nations Office at Nairobi;
2. *Also decides* that, in accordance with the decision taken by the Committee on Conferences to hold its 2000 substantive session at the United Nations Office at Nairobi, in response to section B, paragraph 23, of resolution 54/248, to pay for the travel of one representative of each State member of the Committee from New York to Nairobi, to attend the session;
3. *Encourages* those members of the Committee that have official representation in Nairobi, where feasible, to be represented at the session by their officials in Nairobi;
4. *Requests* those members of the Committee from economically more developed countries, where feasible, to finance their own travel to Nairobi.
