A. WP.29 session

1. ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

In accordance with the Commission's rules of procedure, the first item on the provisional agenda is the adoption of the agenda.

- 2. COORDINATION AND ORGANIZATION OF WORK
- 2.1. The Chairman of the Administrative Committee for the Coordination of Work (WP.29/AC.2) will report on the discussions held during its seventy-third session and submit its proposals for consideration by WP.29.
- 2.2. WP.29 might wish to consider the Programme of Work and Priorities as proposed by the Administrative Committee (WP.29/AC.2) and by the Chairmen of its respective subsidiary Working Parties.

 The secretariat will present a provisional calendar of meetings of WP.29 and its subsidiary bodies for 2001.
- 2.3. The secretariat will inform WP.29 of relevant decisions taken by the Economic Commission for Europe at its fifty-fifth session (3-5 May 2000)
- 2.4. WP.29 may wish to consider its participation in the meeting of the ad hoc multi-disciplinary group of experts on safety in tunnels, scheduled to be held in Geneva, on 10 and 11 July 2000. WP.29 was invited to participate in the work of this group by the Inland Transport Committee, at its sixty-second session (ECE/TRANS/133, para. 43).

3. GLOBAL HARMONIZATION

- 3.1. WP.29 may wish to review developments related to the Agreement of 25 June 1998, particularly with respect to ratifications of the signatures already attached and with respect to any new signatories (TRANS/WP.29/703, paras. 33 and 34).
- 3.2. WP.29 may wish to be informed of the recommendations by the Administrative Committee for the Coordination of Work (WP.29/AC.2) concerning the strategy and priorities for developing future global technical regulations. In this respect, the proposals listed in the programme of work may be considered (TRANS/WP.29/2000/44), recalling also the discussion of this subject during the one-hundred-and-twentieth session of WP.29 (TRANS/WP.29/703, paras. 37-47).
- 3.3. WP.29 agreed to resume its considerations concerning the informal group on "common tasks" and its chairmanship. It was already agreed during the one-hundred-and-twentieth session that this informal group should operate under GRSG, during its regular sessions and propose common definitions of vehicle categories and vehicle masses and dimensions (TRANS/WP.29/703, paras. 17 and 25).

WP.29 may wish to consider and endorse the reports of GRSP, GRRF, GRPE and GRB. In addition, the Chairmen of GRE, GRSG, GRSP and GRPE will report orally on the highlights of the recent sessions.

B. Session of the Administrative Committee (AC.1)

1. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE AC.1

The Administrative Committee shall be composed of all the Contracting Parties in accordance with the rules of procedure set out in Appendix 1 of the Agreement (E/ECE/324-E/ECE/TRANS/505/Rev.2, Article 1, para. 2).

2. DRAFT AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING REGULATIONS - VOTING BY AC.1

Amendments to Regulations shall be established by the Administrative Committee according to the procedure indicated in Appendix 1. Proposed amendments to Regulations shall be put to the vote. Each country, Contracting Party to the Agreement applying the Regulation, shall have one vote. A quorum of not less than half of the Contracting Parties applying the Regulation is required for the purposes of taking decisions. For the determination of the quorum, regional economic integration organizations, being Contracting Parties to the Agreement, vote with the number of votes of their Member States. The representative of a regional economic integration organization may deliver the votes of those of its constituent sovereign countries which apply the Regulation. Draft amendments to Regulations shall be established by a two-thirds majority of those present and voting (Article 12 and Appendix 1).

Contracting Parties experiencing difficulties in attending the sessions of the Administrative Committee AC.1 might be allowed exceptionally to express their views on items considered in writing, or by delegation of their voting power to other Contracting Parties attending the session (TRANS/WP.29/482, para. 11).

If all Contracting Parties to the Agreement agree, any Regulation adopted under the terms of the unamended Agreement may be treated as though it was a Regulation adopted under the terms of the amended Agreement (Article 15, para. 3).

3. NEW DRAFT REGULATIONS - VOTING BY AC.1

The Contracting Parties shall establish, through an Administrative Committee made up of all the Contracting Parties in conformity with the rules of procedure set out in Appendix 1 and on the basis of the following articles and paragraphs, Regulations for wheeled vehicles, equipment and parts which can be fitted and/or be used on wheeled vehicles (Article 1, para. 1).

Proposed new Regulations shall be put to the vote. Each country, Contracting Party to the Agreement, shall have one vote. A quorum consisting of not less than one-half of the Contracting Parties to the Agreement is required for the purpose of taking decisions. For the determination of the quorum, regional economic integration organizations, being Contracting Parties to the Agreement, vote with the number of votes of their Member States. The representative of a regional economic integration organization may deliver the votes of its constituent sovereign countries. New Draft Regulations shall be established by a two-thirds majority of those present and voting (Appendix 1, Article 5).



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
