**Official communiqué of the 4157th meeting of the
Security Council**

**Held in private in the Security Council Chamber at Headquarters,
New York, on Thursday, 15 June 2000, at 3 p.m.**

At its 4157th meeting, held in private on 15 June 2000 at 3 p.m., the Security Council considered the situation concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

The President extended invitations in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter and rules 37 and 39 of its provisional rules of procedure, as appropriate, to the members of the Political Committee for the Implementation of the Lusaka Cease-Fire Agreement, as well as Zambia, the representative of the Current Chairman of the Organization of African Unity and the Special Representative of the Secretary-General for the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

The members of the Council and the members of the Political Committee had a frank and constructive discussion.
