Letter dated 7 July 2000 from the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1132 (1997) concerning Sierra Leone addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 1171 (1998) of 5 June 1998 concerning Sierra Leone, in paragraph 4 of which the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1132 (1997) concerning Sierra Leone is required to report to the Council on notifications received from States on the export of arms and related *matériel* to Sierra Leone, as well as on notifications of imports of arms and related *matériel* made by the Government of Sierra Leone.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that the Committee received a notification on 6 July 2000 from the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland for the export of the following military goods for use by the Ghanaian contingent of the United Nations Mission in Sierra Leone: 800 combat helmets (in United Nations blue) and communications equipment. The aforementioned goods were exported by the United Kingdom on 29 and 30 May 2000 directly from Ghana to Lungi International Airport, Freetown.
