1. Paragraph 7

The first three sentences *should read*:

Since the Organic Act of the United States Virgin Islands (1936) was last revised in 1954, there have been five attempts to draft a local constitution in order to organize the internal mechanisms of government. None of the five attempts were successful. Regarding the Territory's political status, the first and only referendum on a range of political options was conducted in 1993.
