NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

At its 103rd plenary meeting of its thirty-seventh session, on 14 December 1982, the General Assembly adopted resolution 37/101, $\underline{1}$ / entitled "Invasion of Lesotho by South Africa". In paragraph 3 of that resolution, the General Assembly

"3. Urges the Security Council to take immediate steps to deter South Africa from repeating its acts of aggression against and destabilization of Lesotho and other neighbouring independent African States."

At its 2407th meeting, on 15 December 1982, the Security Council adopted resolution 527 (1982), in connection with the item "Complaint by Lesotho against South Africa". 2/
