

Note verbale dated 21 July 2000 from the Permanent Mission of Pakistan to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Pakistan to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1132 (1997) concerning Sierra Leone and has the honour to convey the following concerning implementation of Council resolution 1306 (2000) of 5 July 2000 on Sierra Leone:

- (a) The Government of Pakistan abides by all the requisite obligations and has been ensuring strict implementation of the arms embargo imposed against Sierra Leone;
- (b) The policy of the Government of Pakistan has been in line with the Security Council resolution curbing the flow of arms to Sierra Leone;
- (c) In this regard, all concerned authorities have been advised to strictly implement the arms embargo imposed on Sierra Leone.
