Letter dated 1 August 2000 from the Permanent Representative of the Democratic Republic of the Congo to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to transmit herewith a document entitled: "May we not forget that they died for their acts of welcome, love and protection".*

This document consists of a collection of eyewitness accounts of the massacres perpetrated in the eastern part of the Democratic Republic of the Congo by the armies of Rwanda, Uganda and Burundi.

I should be grateful if you would have the text of this letter and its annex circulated as a document of the Security Council.
