Explanatory memorandum

The scale of assessments for peacekeeping operations has not been comprehensively updated since its inception in 1973. Since maintaining peace and security continues to be one of the Organization's most crucial tasks, we believe it is necessary to review the current scale to ensure that it can support current and future peacekeeping activities.

In our view, the Fifth Committee would be the appropriate forum to consider this issue during the main part of the fifty-fifth session of the General Assembly.
