

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Mauritius to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1267 (1999) concerning Afghanistan, and with reference to its note dated 1 June 2000, has the honour to inform that no incident relating to the Taliban has been signalled in Mauritius and the authorities concerned have taken the necessary steps to implement the above-mentioned resolution. Moreover, the Government of Mauritius has decided that Mr. Usama Bin Laden requires the prior approval of the Prime Minister's Office before he undertakes any travel to Mauritius.
