Status of prior amendments to the AGR

Note by the secretariat

In depositary notification C.N. 380.1999.TREATIES-1, dated 2 June 1999 (as reproduced in TRANS/SC.1/2000/4, annex 1), reference was made to the proposal to extend the E 97 from Novorossiysk to Kherson and to suppress the stretch from Poti to Trabzon.

The proposal should also have made mention of the suppression of the section of the E 97 from Trabzon through Gumushane to Askale, as proposed by the Turkish authorities. The new overall reference as given in C.N.380.1999.TREATIES-1 is, however, correct:
