LETTER DATED 13 JULY 1988 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE LAO PEOPLE'S DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Message from the Acting President of the Lao People's Democratic Republic addressed to the President of the Islamic Republic of Iran

We were profoundly sad to learn of the destruction of the Iranian civilian aircraft on 3 July 1988 above the Persian Gulf by the American warship. This tragedy, which cost the lives of 298 passengers and crew members, is the direct consequence of the policy of force pursued by a great Power in that region. The Lao Government hopes that the dangerous situation prevailing in that region can be defused, in order to prevent another tragedy.

On behalf of the people and Government of the Lao People's Democratic Republic and in my personal capacity, I share the profound sorrow of the Iranian people and Government and of the grieving families.
