Foreign Minister Alwi Shihab will return to New York on October 11-12 to brief the United Nations Security Council and the Secretary General on the progress the Indonesian government has made in implementation of the UN Security Council Resolution 1319 (2000).

Upon his return to New York, the Foreign Minister will also work out a plan, in conjunction with the Security Council, on a date for the Security Council delegation to visit Indonesia, whose objective will be to observe the progress made by Indonesia in carrying out the Security Council Resolution .

On September 19, Indonesian Coordinating Minister for Political, Social and Security Affairs Soesilo Bambang Yudhoyono and Foreign Minister Alwi Shihab met with the UN Security Council, the Secretary-General and other members of the United Nations to outline the government of Indonesia's plan to address the situation in West Timor.
