

Draft decision submitted by the Rapporteur following informal consultations

Programme budget implications of General Assembly resolution 54/283 on the review of the problem of human immunodeficiency virus/aquired immunodeficiency syndrome in all its aspects

The Fifth Committee:

Reaffirming rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly,

Recalling paragraph 3 of General Assembly resolution 54/283 of 5 September 2000,

Decides to inform the General Assembly that, subject to the provisions for the operation and use of the contingency fund, implementation of General Assembly resolution 54/283 could require \$1,628,900 over and above the resources in the programme budget for the biennium 2000-2001 as follows: \$790,000 under section 1, overall policy-making, direction and coordination; \$585,200 under section 26, public information; and \$253,700 under section 27, management and central support services.
