WORLD HERITAGE - SPAIN

- On 6 October 2000, the United Nations Postal Administration (UNPA) will issue a set of six commemorative stamps and three prestige booklets on the theme "World Heritage - Spain".
- 2. The stamps will be issued in three currencies (US dollar, Swiss Francs and Austrian Shillings). The denominations of the stamps are S.Fr. 1.00 and 1.20, US\$ 0.33 and 0.60, AS 4.50/ Euro 0.33 and AS 6.50/ Euro 0.47.



3. The three prestige booklets contain 24 mint stamps each (12 x US\$ 0.05 and 12 x US\$ 0.15 for New York, 12 x S.Fr. 0.10 and 12 x S.Fr. 0.20 for Geneva, 12 x AS 1/ Euro 0.07 and 12 x AS 2/ Euro 0.14 for Vienna) and are priced at the face





- 4. Staff members and mission personnel wishing to procure these stamps, prestige booklets and first day covers can obtain them from 9 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. on 6 October 2000, at the UNPA sales counter at door 6 of the Palais des Nations.
- 5. Staff members are encouraged to use United Nations stamps on their personal mail. By doing so, these miniature messengers of peace can educate unseen thousands of people to the activities and goals of the United Nations.
