The Federal Republic of Germany has fulfilled its obligation by publishing regulation (EC) No. 337/2000 in the Federal Gazette (*Bundesanzeiger*) No. 105 of 6 June 2000 (p. 10437), thus ensuring the application of section 34 (4) of the Foreign Trade and Payments Act.
