B. Session of the Administrative Committee AC.1

1. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE AC.1

2. DRAFT AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING REGULATIONS - VOTING BY AC.1

The Committee will vote on the proposals under items 6.1. to 6.22. of part A of the agenda, taking account of the recommendations by WP.29. The proposals under agenda items 7.1. to 7.11. will only be voted on in conjunction with the vote on agenda items 8.1. to 8.3. (see below).

3. NEW DRAFT REGULATIONS - VOTING BY AC.1

The Committee will vote on the proposals under items 8.1. to 8.5. of part A of the agenda, taking account of the recommendations by WP.29.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

A. WP.29 session

1. ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

In accordance with Chapter III, Rule 7 of the Rules of Procedure of WP.29 (TRANS/WP.29/690), the first item on the provisional agenda is the adoption of the agenda.

2. ELECTION OF OFFICERS FOR THE YEAR 2001

Following the provisions of Chapter V, Rule 13 of its Rules of Procedure (TRANS/WP.29/690), WP.29 will elect its Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson(s), who shall take office at the one-hundred-and-twenty-third session, in March 2001.

3. COORDINATION AND ORGANIZATION OF WORK

- 3.1. The Chairman of the Administrative Committee for the Coordination of Work (WP.29/AC.2) will report on the discussions held during its seventy-fourth session and submit its proposals for consideration by WP.29.
- 3.2. WP.29 might wish to consider the Programme of Work and Priorities as proposed by the Administrative Committee (WP.29/AC.2) and by the Chairmen of its respective subsidiary Working Parties.
- 3.3. The secretariat was informed (on 2 August 2000) that an Islamic holiday (Eid al Adha) will be observed by the United Nations on 5 March 2001. Therefore, the seventy-fifth session of WP.29/AC.2 cannot be held as scheduled (TRANS/WP.29/735, annex 2). After considering possible alternatives and taking into account the confirmed dates of the Geneva Motor Show in March 2001, the secretariat requests WP.29 to consider the following proposal:

Administrative Committee (WP.29/AC.2), seventy-fifth: 6 March 2001, morning only,

World Forum (WP.29), one-hundred-and-twenty-third: starting 6 March 2001 at 14.30 h,

i.e. both sessions cut short by one-half day.

- 3.4. The secretariat will transmit to WP.29 the report of the first meeting of the group (10 and 11 July 2000) and provide a brief information about the second meeting (10 and 11 October 2000).

4. GLOBAL HARMONIZATION

- 4.1. Following the entry into force on 25 August 2000, WP.29 may wish to review developments concerning the Agreement of 25 June 1998, in particular with respect to new signatories.

The Contracting Parties to the Agreement may also wish to consider the schedule of the meetings of the Executive Committee and the questions of administration of the Compendium of Candidate Global Technical Regulations and the Registry of Global Technical Regulations.

- 4.2. WP.29 shall consider the strategy and priorities for developing future global technical regulations (gtr), taking into account not only the proposals already listed in its programme of work (TRANS/WP.29/2000/44), but also proposals which had been received during the past sessions as various informal documents and the new proposals expected to be received from other parties, including the European Community and the United States of America upon the invitation made during the one-hundred-and-twenty-first session (TRANS/WP.29/735, para. 13).

4.3. WP.29 may wish to receive a brief information about the first meeting of the informal group on "common tasks", held on 16 and 17 October 2000, prior to the seventy-ninth session of GRSG (TRANS/WP.29/735, paras. 39 and 40).

5. CONSIDERATION OF THE REPORTS OF THE WORKING PARTIES
SUBSIDIARY TO WP.29

WP.29 may wish to consider and endorse the reports of GRE, GRSG, GRSP and GRPE. In addition, the Chairmen of GRRF, GRB, GRE and GRSG will report orally on the highlights of the recent sessions.

Please note that during its one-hundred-and-twenty-first session, WP.29 decided to consider the proposal for draft Rule No. 2 (inspection of vehicles with respect to safety) together with the proposal for draft revision of annex 2 to the Consolidated Resolution R.E.1 at its session of March 2001 (TRANS/WP.29/735, paras. 99-106).

11. OTHER BUSINESS

- 11.1. WP.29 agreed to consider the draft of the publication which in its updated version is titled "World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) - How it Works - How to Join it" compiled from the various contributions and the existing documents; as requested, document TRANS/WP.29/2000/66 is complete and includes all graphics in an electronic format (TRANS/WP.29/735, paras. 107-109).

12. ADOPTION OF THE REPORT

In accordance with established practice, WP.29 will adopt the report on its one-hundred-and-twenty-second session on the basis of the draft prepared by the secretariat.

The report shall also include a section referring to the sixteenth session of the Administrative Committee (AC.1) of the amended 1958 Agreement.

B. Session of the Administrative Committee (AC.1)

1. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE AC.1

The Administrative Committee shall be composed of all the Contracting Parties in accordance with the rules of procedure set out in Appendix 1 of the 1958 Agreement (E/ECE/324-E/ECE/TRANS/505/Rev.2, Article 1, para. 2).

2. DRAFT AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING REGULATIONS - VOTING BY AC.1

Amendments to Regulations shall be established by the Administrative Committee according to the procedure indicated in Appendix 1. Proposed amendments to Regulations shall be put to the vote. Each country, Contracting Party to the Agreement applying the Regulation, shall have one vote. A quorum of not less than half of the Contracting Parties applying the Regulation is required for the purposes of taking decisions. For the determination of the quorum, regional economic integration organizations, being Contracting Parties to the Agreement, vote with the number of votes of their Member States. The representative of a regional economic integration organization may deliver the votes of those of its constituent sovereign countries which apply the Regulation. Draft amendments to Regulations shall be established by a two-thirds majority of those present and voting (Article 12 and Appendix 1).

Contracting Parties experiencing difficulties in attending the sessions of the Administrative Committee AC.1 might be allowed exceptionally to express their views on items considered in writing, or by delegation of their voting power to other Contracting Parties attending the session (TRANS/WP.29/482, para. 11).

If all Contracting Parties to the Agreement agree, any Regulation adopted under the terms of the unamended Agreement may be treated as though it was a Regulation adopted under the terms of the amended Agreement (Article 15, para. 3).

3. NEW DRAFT REGULATIONS - VOTING BY AC.1

The Contracting Parties shall establish, through an Administrative Committee made up of all the Contracting Parties in conformity with the rules of procedure set out in Appendix 1 and on the basis of the following articles and paragraphs, Regulations for wheeled vehicles, equipment and parts which can be fitted and/or be used on wheeled vehicles (Article 1, para. 1).

Proposed new Regulations shall be put to the vote. Each country, Contracting Party to the Agreement, shall have one vote. A quorum consisting of not less than one-half of the Contracting Parties to the Agreement is required for the purpose of taking decisions. For the determination of the quorum, regional economic integration organizations, being Contracting Parties to the Agreement, vote with the number of votes of their Member States. The representative of a regional economic integration organization may deliver the votes of its constituent sovereign countries. New Draft Regulations shall be established by a two-thirds majority of those present and voting (Appendix 1, Article 5).
