LETTER DATED 19 FEBRUARY 1983 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF THE LIBYAN ARAB JAMAHIRIYA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO
THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Upon instruction from my country, I have the honour to request Your Excellency to call an urgent meeting of the Security Council to consider the deteriorating situation near the Libyan shores that could jeopardize the security and peace of the region and the world.

This situation which rose from the provocative military actions of the United States Administration by moving its aircraft-carrier NIMITZ with some naval vessels close to the Libyan coast and sending 4 awacs aircraft to one of the neighbouring countries of Libyan Arab Jamahiriya which spy and work against Libya.
