**Jordan**

1. Jordan does not apply any unilateral laws that impose economic sanctions or boycotts on the companies or individuals of other States.
2. Jordan is not bound to comply with or apply any coercive extraterritorial economic measures or laws imposed unilaterally by any State.
3. Jordan is not bound to apply the economic sanctions or boycott measures of any State if such sanctions or measures are contrary to the principles of international law.
