

Proposals and contributions received from Governments

Colombia: amendments to articles 7 quinquiens and 15 of the revised draft Protocol against the Smuggling of Migrants by Land, Air and Sea, supplementing the United Nations Convention against Transnational Organized Crime

Article 7 quinquiens: Measures for the protection of migrants

- 1. Colombia is in favour of retaining article 7 *quinquiens* within the text of the Protocol but proposes the addition of a new paragraph as follows:
 - "(...) In applying the provisions of this article, States Parties shall take into account the special needs of women and children."

Article 15: Return of smuggled migrants

- 2. With regard to article 15, it is proposed that a new paragraph be added as follows:
 - "(...) States Parties shall make the necessary provision for the repatriation of a smuggled migrant, either to the person's country of origin or to the country in which the person had the right of abode, and shall guarantee the person's safe return."
