LETTER DATED 16 MARCH 1983 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
CHAD TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to request you to call an urgent meeting of the Security Council in order to consider the extremely serious situation prevailing in Chad as a result of the occupation of a part of Chad territory by Libya and of repeated acts of aggression by that country against the people of Chad.

Indeed, since 1973, Libya has not only been in military occupation of that part of Chad territory commonly known as "Bande d'Aouzou", but has also been openly intervening in the internal affairs of Chad, in flagrant violation of the United Nations Charter and of the relevant resolutions of the General Assembly.
