Letter dated 27 November 2000 from the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1132 (1997) concerning Sierra Leone addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to resolution 1171 (1998), adopted by the Security Council on 5 June 1998, concerning Sierra Leone. In paragraph 4 of the resolution, the Committee is required to report to the Council on notifications received from States on the export of arms and related materiel to Sierra Leone, as well as on notifications of imports of arms and related materiel made by the Government of Sierra Leone.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that the Committee established pursuant to resolution 1132 (1997) concerning Sierra Leone, received a notification on 22 November 2000, from the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, for the export of the following military equipment for use in the Ghanaian contingent serving in the United Nations Mission in Sierra Leone (UNAMSIL): 1 Simrad LP7 laser rangefinder; 1 BC30 battery charger; and 5 pairs of Simrad binoculars. These items of equipment were shipped to Accra on 19 October 2000.
