Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments

Appointment of members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 9th plenary meeting, on 11 September 2000, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fifty-fifth session the item entitled "Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions".
2. At its 20th meeting, on 3 November 2000, the Fifth Committee had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/55/101) concerning the vacancies in the membership of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions that will occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of five of its members on 31 December 2000.
3. The Fifth Committee also had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/55/4) containing the names of eight persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment or reappointment to the Advisory Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2001.
4. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint Manlan Narcisse Ahounou (Côte d'Ivoire) and E. Besley Maycock (Barbados) as members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2001.
5. The Fifth Committee then proceeded to elect, by secret ballot, one person from the remaining two candidates proposed by the African States. The result of the voting was as follows:

6. Having obtained the required majority, C. S. M. Mselle (United Republic of Tanzania) was recommended for appointment as a member of the Advisory Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2001.

7. The Fifth Committee then proceeded to elect, by secret ballot, one person from the candidates proposed by the Asian States. The result of the voting was as follows:

8. Having obtained the required majority, Felipe Mabilangan (Philippines) was recommended for appointment as a member of the Advisory Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2001.

9. The Fifth Committee then further proceeded to elect, by secret ballot, one person from the candidates proposed by the Eastern European States. The result of the voting was as follows:
