LETTER DATED 25 JULY 1988 FROM THE ACTING PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO
THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that at 1404 hours, on Saturday 23 July 1988, the Iraqi forces brought Sardasht under artillery fire, as a result of which 5 civilians were martyred and 15 others injured.

On 24 July 1988, the city of Kazand-e-Gharb was bombarded by enemy warplanes, as a result of which 7 civilians were martyred and 50 others injured.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter were circulated as a document of the Security Council.
