Letter dated 26 July 1988 from the Secretary of the People's
Committee of the People's Bureau for Foreign Liaison of the
Libyan Arab Jamahiriya addressed to the President of the
Security Council

The United States of America is intending to dispatch 1,000 American Marines to occupied Palestine on the pretext of conducting land and air exercises, thereby transforming Arab territory in occupied Palestine into a training ground with the aim of terrorizing the Arab people in Palestine and in an attempt to suppress the uprising.

The military alliance between the United States and the Zionist entity is targeted first and foremost at the Arab existence in its entirety, besides heightening tension and threatening international peace and security in the region. This criminal role which the United States is playing in co-ordination with the Zionist entity is confirmed by its provision of material and moral support and by its military presence in the region.

In drawing your attention to the seriousness of these developments on the part of the United States Government - and trusting in your wisdom - we urge the distinguished Council to take all the urgent action and measures needed to safeguard international peace and security and to spare the region from further tension arising from the American military presence.
