Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1132 (1997) concerning Sierra Leone

Note verbale dated 4 December 2000 from the Permanent Mission of Belarus to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Belarus to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1132 (1997) concerning Sierra Leone and, with reference to his note dated 14 September 2000, has the honour to inform him of the following.

In accordance with the commitments of Belarus under the Charter of the United Nations the Government of the Republic of Belarus has completed all the necessary procedures and has taken all the relevant measures in order to implement paragraph 2 of section A and paragraph 17 of section B of the Security Council resolution 1306 (2000) of 5 July 2000.

The Republic of Belarus supports the efforts of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1132 (1997) concerning Sierra Leone aimed at the effective implementation of the coercive measures imposed against Sierra Leone.

The Republic of Belarus welcomes the peaceful settlement of the conflict in Sierra Leone based on the Peace Agreement signed by the conflict parties at Lomé, on 7 July 2000, as well as the commitment of all States to sovereignty, political independence and territorial integrity of Sierra Leone.
