Letter dated 15 January 2001 from the Permanent Representative of Lebanon to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

On instructions from my Government, and following my previous letters, I have the honour to inform you of a series of Israeli violations of Lebanese sovereignty which occurred on 14 January 2001:

1400	Beirut-Mount Lebanon/military aircraft, breaking the sound barrier	
1445	North Beirut/military aircraft	Medium altitude
2200-2210	Military helicopters opposite Naqurah	

Violations on 14 January 2001

This new series of Israeli violations, which follows upon previous violations, constitutes a flagrant violation of Security Council resolution 425 (1978) and of the sovereignty of Lebanon, and is a threat to stability in the region.
