#### **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

The first meeting of the Working Group on Pollutant Release and Transfer Registers is convened in the light of the decision of the Committee on Environmental Policy, following a recommendation from the Meeting of the Signatories to the Convention, to establish an openended intergovernmental working group charged with the preparation of a legally binding instrument on pollutant release and transfer registers, with a view to having such an instrument ready for the fifth Ministerial 'Environment for Europe' Conference (ECE/CEP/74, para. 30 (b), and CEP/WG.5/2000/2, para. 28 (c) respectively).

#### <u>Item 1.</u> <u>Election of officers</u>

The Working Group will elect a chairperson and may elect other officers.

# Item 2. Adoption of the agenda

The Working Group is expected to adopt the agenda as set out in the present document.

# Item 3. Preparation of a draft instrument on pollutant release and transfer registers

The Working Group is expected to start to prepare the draft text of a legally binding instrument on pollutant release and transfer registers. The secretariat has prepared a working document, with the assistance of a small number of experts serving in a personal capacity (CEP/WG.5/AC.2/2001/3). The Working Group may wish to use this document as a starting point for discussions.
